Dalradian Gold to create hundreds of jobs in Tyrone with goldmine plans

Dalradian Gold will open its doors to the public this weekend to further consult on plans to build a goldmine in Co Tyrone.

The company has been exploring and developing the high grade gold deposit at Curraghinalt and held an initial series of consultations in January of this year. This next round of consultation events is to update the community on progress to date and the next steps involved in preparing for the submission of a planning application.

The latest studies show that the new project will create hundreds of new jobs, both during the construction phase and through the lifetime of the mine.

This would provide a significant boost to the economy in Northern Ireland and to County Tyrone in particular. As part of the company's commitment to the region and to the immediate local area, it will aim to maximise local employment including through training programmes and upskilling.

At these consultation events members of the public and other stakeholders can find out more information about the jobs that will be made available and some of the initiatives the company has been working on with the community and on environmental awareness and protection.

A team of experts will also be in attendance at the events to answer questions on the environmental studies, including on water, noise, air, the Feasibility Study and the planning application.

Director of Stakeholder Engagement, Dr Anne Monaghan said:

"The events this weekend are part of the consultation process with the local community on our plans to build a gold mine in Tyrone. We are really keen to hear people's views and answer questions they have about the project and will have a full team of experts on hand at both events.

"Our work to date demonstrates that what we have here is a truly remarkable deposit in terms of size and quality of the resource. If given planning permission the mine will transform the economy in this area and create hundreds of direct jobs in the process.

"We would encourage everyone with an interest in this project to come and see for themselves what the project involves, and what a mine can deliver for the area and the people who live and work here."

- The Pre-Application Community Consultation Events will be held on Saturday 19th November (10:00am – 4:00pm) and on Monday, 21st November (4:00pm – 9:00pm).
- These are being held at Dalradian's current site just West of 45 Camcosy Road, Rouskey, BT79 7SF.
- The Curraghinalt Project is a gold exploration project located near the villages of Greencastle, Rouskey and Gortin in County Tyrone. To date, the company's investment into the project has exceeded £56 million and has included extensive mineral exploration, community engagement and consultation, and environmental studies to inform an environmental impact assessment and a feasibility study, both due to be completed in the autumn.
- If approved, the project is expected to last for more than twenty years.
- The company currently employs 44 people directly, of which over 60% are from County Tyrone, with over 90% living in the County. Because many employees, contractors and suppliers come from the area and live locally, the project has already made a substantial contribution to the local supply chain and economy.
- Dalradian has undertaken an extensive stakeholder engagement programme which will continue throughout the life of the project. Dalradian is fully committed to providing benefits to the area in which it works and has offices in both Gortin and Omagh to ensure that local residents can raise issues directly with the company.
- The Tyrone Fund has provided £220,000 to date to local community initiatives. In addition to providing funds, Dalradian personnel have spent approximately 500 staff hours supporting community projects.
